

City Council met in regular session at 5:00 p.m. on April 25, 2017 at the Council Rooms Sac City Municipal Building with the following members present: Bill Brenny, Teresa Bruening, Bruce Perry, Larry Mahler, Tom McGinty, with Scott Bundt, Mayor presiding.

There were no conflicts of interest noted from the council.

A motion was made by Bruce Perry and seconded by Teresa Bruening to approve the following consent agenda items:

Approval of the agenda.

Approval of the minutes of the April 11, 2017 council meeting.

Appointing Brandy Ripley to the Sac City Hometown Pride Committee.

Approval of a fireworks contract with J & M Displays, Inc.

Approval of Sac City Chamber Main Street's application for a noise pollution permit.

Approval of receipts and disbursements for March 2017.

Roll call was taken and vote was as follows:

The Mayor proclaimed April as KEEP IOWA BEAUTIFUL month.

Denise Opsal addressed the council with her concerns of discrimination in regard to planning and zoning regulations.

The trails committee addressed the council in regard to bike trails inside the city limits. The committee proposed additional bike routes as outlined in a sample brochure, it was moved by Bruce Perry and seconded by Tom McGinty to approve the designated four bike routes. Roll call was taken and vote was as follows:

The council discussed at length the monies it received (\$15,099.20) due to the dissolution of the American Legion Trust. During the discussion the white crosses placed at the cemetery for veterans was discussed and the future of that project with the dissolution of the American Legion. The Sac City Fire Department graciously agreed to continue to provide that recognition and will continue to provide and place the crosses at the cemetery. It was moved by Bruce Perry and seconded by Larry Mahler to donate \$10,000.00 to the fire department trust and agency account for the purchase of a new aerial truck. Roll call was taken and vote was as follows:

A motion was made by Bruce Perry and seconded by Teresa Bruening to increase bulk water sales to 2.75 times the water rate. Roll call was taken and vote was as follows:
